All the Chief Coordinators of the Examination Centers are requested to

- 1) Conduct Practical Examinations and complete them as per the time table. If the practical examinations are postponed, please inform the further date of practical to the students well in advance. Any misbehavior by the candidate at the examination hall may be dealt with seriously.
- 2) For all the courses each theory paper consists of 100 marks (i.e. external exam for 80 marks + internal exam for 20 marks). Pass mark is 40% (i.e. 40 marks)
- 3) Internal exams are conducted by the Colleges only and marks will be submitted by the Colleges/Institutions to the Board.
- 4) Practical examination for DMLT course is for 60 marks (i.e. two experiments at @ 15 marks each + viva @ 20marks + spotters @ 10marks) and there are 3 practical exams for DMLT course. Pass mark is 40% (i.e. 24 marks)
- 5) For all the other courses only one practical exam for 100 marks (i.e. two experiments at @ 25 marks each + viva @ 30 marks + spotters @ 20 marks). Pass mark is 40% (i.e. 40 marks)
- 6) The candidate has to write the examination within the booklet provided and no additional sheets will be provided.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PARA MEDICAL INSTITUTIONS

The application form for examination and other details are available in Website www.tgpmb.telangana.gov.in

All the principals of Para Medical Institutions are requested to:

1. Enclose copy of the previous hall ticket along with the application form (online filled) for supplementary candidates.
2. Application should be signed with seal and email address of principal paramedical Institutions for correspondence with signature of the candidate, and principal of the Paramedical Institute.
3. After approval by the Secretary, TGPMB, download the hall tickets from their respective institutes.
4. For all the courses each theory paper consists of 100 marks (i.e. external exam for 80 marks + internal exam for 20 marks). Pass mark is 40% (i.e. 40 marks)
5. Internal exams are conducted by the Colleges only and marks have to be submitted by the Colleges/Institutions to the Board duly signed by the concerned Principal of the College/Institute.
6. Practical examination for DMLT course is for 60 marks (i.e. two experiments at @ 15 marks each + viva @ 20marks + spotters @ 10marks) and there are 3 practical exams for DMLT course. Pass mark is 40% (i.e. 24 marks)
7. For all the other courses only one practical exam for 100 marks (i.e. two experiments at @ 25 marks each + viva @ 30 marks + spotters @ 20 marks). Pass mark is 40% (i.e. 40 marks)
8. All the correspondence has to be made to the secretary TG Para Medical Board, Hyderabad and contact number for any clarification is 040-24653519.
9. The candidate has to write the examination within the booklet provided and no additional sheets will be provided.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM:-

1. The students writing supplementary exams have to submit the application hard copy.
2. The Name should be entered as recorded in SSC marks list. No corrections will be made after submitting the application in TGPMB office.
3. Once fees are paid, it is not refundable/adjustable.
4. Photo background should be plain.
5. Signature of the candidate in the application form and Hall Ticket form along with the signature and seal of the Principal of the institution should be there.
6. Submit all the applications along with SSC, Inter Marks Memos & previous hall ticket printouts to TGPMB office.
7. The attached photo in the application which is submitted in the TGPMB Office must be attested by the principal along with the college seal. Else the application will be rejected. Attach extra photos for scan purpose along with application form.
8. Any queries regarding filling/submitting of online examination applications contact No.040-24653519.
9. The Hall tickets can be downloaded by the institutions after the scrutiny by the Board for all the students.
10. Maximum number of attempts that a student can appear is four (4) academic years.

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. Candidates should verify the entries printed in the hall ticket carefully. Any discrepancy should be brought to the notice of the principal of their college for rectification.
2. Candidates should occupy the seats allotted to them in the examination hall at least one hour before the commencement of the examination.
3. Candidates should carry their hall ticket ready with them for inspection by the Chief/Asst/Superintendent/Departments Officers of the examination centre or any officer authorized for this purpose at time during the examination.
4. Candidates should receive the correct question paper from the invigilator concerned.
5. Candidates should not write their names/Regd. Nos. in any part of the answer book.
6. Questions of very short answer type should be answered at one place in the same order given in the question paper.
7. Strict silence should be maintained in the examination hall.
8. Candidates should write the answers in English language only
9. Candidates are liable to be booked under malpractices Act, if they indulge in,
 - a) Bringing any kind of written/printed material/books in to the examination hall.
 - b) Noting down the answers on the question papers/hall tickets.
 - c) Copying from others.
 - d) Possession of cell phone and other electronic gadgets.
10. They are also punishable under TG Public Examinations Act No.25 of1997.
11. Candidates writing the examination at a centre other than the allotted one are liable for cancellation of their performance.
12. The candidate has to write the examination within the booklet provided and no additional sheets will be provided.

COVID PROTOCOLS
