I am to invite your attention to the references cited and inform you that in the reference 4th cited the DPH&FW, Hyd has reported that the Principal, Regional Health & Family Welfare Training Centre (Male), Hyderabad has compared the curriculams of MPHW(M) and Sanitary Inspector Course of CSTRI and opined that some subjects in the MPHW(M) course were not included in the sanitary Inspector Course of CSTRI and there is a variance in the syllabus. In view of the above, the Government have taken a view that the Sanitary Inspector Course of CSTRI cannot be treated as equivalent to MPHW course. Therefore, the clarification issued vide reference 2nd cited that the NTC in Sanitary Inspector Course at Kollapur in Mahabubnagar District and Yadagirigutta in Nalgonda District is not recognized under section 24 of APPMB act and the curriculum of both the courses is not equivalent and the said clarification holds good.
