ORDER:

The Registrar, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Telangana in the letter 6<sup>th</sup> read above, has proposed certain amendments to Government Orders on the Telangana Allied Health Sciences Courses Admission Rules, 2022 vide G.O. 4<sup>th</sup> read above, in view of the completion of ten (10) years period after formation of Telangana State and to delete the Institute of Preventive Medicine Public Health Labs & Food(H) Administration, Institute of Preventive Medicine College of Medical Lab Technology, Narayanaguda, Hyderabad from the State-wide institutions list to protect the interests of Telangana students

2. Section 95 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014 (Central Act No.6 of 2014). provides that the existing admission quotas in all Government or private, aided or unaided, institutions of higher, technical and medical education in so far as they are provided under article 371-D of the Constitution, shall continue as such for a period of ten (10) years during which the existing common admission process shall continue.

3. Consequent upon expiry of the period of ten (10) years provided in section-95 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act 2014, the Government, after careful examination of the matter, have decided to de-notify the Institute of Preventive Medicine Public Health Labs & Food(H) Administration, Institute of Preventive Medicine College of Medical Lab Technology, Narayanaguda, Hyderabad as State-wide Institution to protect the interests of Telangana students and to amend the Government Orders on the Telangana Allied Health Sciences Courses Admission Rules, 2022 vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> read above.

4. Accordingly the following notification shall be published in the Telangana Gazette, Dated: 05.10.2024.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 read with sub-section (1) of section 15 of the Telangana Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (Act No.5 of 1983), the Government of Telangana hereby make the following amendments to

The Telangana Allied Health Sciences Courses Admission Rules, 2022, issued vide G.O.Ms.No. 173, HM & FW (CI) Department, dated 31.12.2022.

AMENDMENT

In the said rules,

(1) in Rule 2, the following sub-rules shall be added after sub-rule (h), namely :-

(i) 'Allied Health Sciences Courses' means courses which are notified in the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Professions Act,2021 (Central Act No. 14 of 2021) published in the Gazette of India No.16, New Delhi, Dated:28.03.2021 and any course notified by Government of Telangana.

(j) 'Local candidate' means a candidate who fulfils the conditions prescribed in Rule 3 (a) for admission into under graduate Allied Health Sciences courses under the competent authority quota in Telangana.

(2) In Rule 3 for sub-rule (a), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(a) Nationality & Domicile: A candidate for admission into Allied Health Sciences courses under 'Competent Authority Quota' in Telangana should be Indian National/Person of Indian Origin (PIO)/Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) card holder and shall fulfill the following conditions:

i) The candidate should have studied in the Educational Institutions in the state of Telangana for a period of not less than four (4) consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.

or

ii) Where during the whole or any part of the four (4) consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he has not studied in Educational Institutions, the candidate should have resided in the state of Telangana for a period of not less than four (4) years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination, in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared.

iii) Further, in case the candidate has not studied in any educational institution and has resided in the State of Telangana as stated at (ii) above, to be eligible for admission into under graduate Allied Health Sciences courses under Competent Authority Quota, the candidate should have appeared for the relevant qualifying examination in the State of Telangana. “

3) In the said rules, in Rule-4, sub-rule (e) and (f) shall be deleted.

4) Rule-5, shall be deleted.

5) In Rule-9:

i. sub-rule (ix) shall be deleted.

ii. Sub-rule (x) the following shall be substituted namely:-

Only local candidates shall be eligible for admission under  
Competent authority quota.

6) In Rule-10, sub-rule (t) and (u), shall be deleted.
